

COVID-19 TRAVEL GUIDE 2021/2022

Please review all the information below in advance of your trip as there are important steps that need to be completed before you travel.

ARRIVING INTO CANADA

The Canadian border is currently open for international tourism, however you will need the following before entering the country:-

1. Double vaccinated with the latest dose administered at least 14-days before departure
2. Negative PCR test taken 72hrs before plane departure
3. Quarantine is not required however you will need to provide details of a quarantine plan in case you catch Covid-19
4. All details above to be submitted to ArriveCAN

Double Vaccinated

Canada is only allowing entry to international travellers who have been double vaccinated. They will accept the following vaccines:

- Pfizer-BioNTech (Comirnaty, tozinameran, BNT162b2)
- Moderna (mRNA-1273)
- AstraZeneca/COVISHIELD (ChAdOx1-S, Vaxzevria, AZD1222)
- Janssen/Johnson & Johnson (Ad26.COV2.S)

You must have had your final dose of the vaccine at least 14 whole days before you travel and be able to demonstrate this on arrival in Canada (with proof uploaded to ArrivaCAN in advance – see below). UK guests can use the [NHS COVID Pass](#).

PCR Test to Travel

Everyone flying to Canada must take a **PCR test within 72 hours of the scheduled departure time of your flight to Canada**. Airlines will refuse boarding to travellers who are unable to provide a valid PCR test result. Antigen and lateral flow tests will not be accepted.

Quarantine Plan

Even though you do not need to quarantine upon entry into Canada, you must submit a quarantine plan and you will need to confirm you have a suitable place to quarantine where you: stay for 14 days or possibly longer, have access to the necessities of life, including water, food, medication, and heat without leaving quarantine. can avoid contact with others who did not travel with you and have no visits from family or guests. We are working with hotels to provide details of a quarantine plan if required.

ArriveCAN

Before you depart to Canada you must have submitted all the relevant documents to ArriveCAN. You can access ArriveCAN through the website: <https://arrivecan.cbsa-asfc.cloud-nuage.canada.ca/privacy> or download the ArriveCAN app through the app store on your phone.

RETURNING TO THE UK

Before returning to the UK you will need:

1. A negative covid test taken 72hrs before flight departure
2. A pre-ordered day 2 test – to be taken on the second day after you have returned to the UK
3. A completed passenger locator form

Currently, quarantine is not required upon arrival in the UK from Canada.

If you are not travelling back to the UK, please check the entry requirements of the country you are returning to or contact us for guidance.

COVID Test to Travel

You will need a negative lateral flow COVID-19 test taken within 72hrs of your departure (based on your airline departure time). This test can be done with a private lateral flow kit which you can pre-order and take with you to Canada. Please note that the UK government will not accept NHS lateral flow tests. Day 2 Test

On returning to the UK, you must take a Day 2 PCR COVID test ON or BEFORE day 2. You will need to **pre-order** your day 2 test as you will need your order number for the passenger locator form (see below). The day 2 test must be PCR test provided by one of the suppliers on the Government's approved [list](#).

Passenger Locator Form

You must complete a passenger locator form online before you arrive in the UK. You must complete the form even if you are only transiting through the UK. You can submit the form any time in the 48 hours before you arrive in the UK. You'll need to show your form when you check in. You can access the form here:
