ArriveCAN App – Step-by-Step Guide (Version 17-12-21)

You must use ArriveCAN, which is free to use, to enter your proof of vaccination, quarantine and travel information within 72 hours of your travel to Canada.

If you don't provide the required information in ArriveCAN before arriving at the border you won't be considered as a fully vaccinated traveller, even if you meet all the other requirements.
